



Are you looking to recognize excellence in the fraternity world? The NIC's Awards of Distinction are the preeminent honor for students, volunteers, campuses and groups that exemplify fraternal values and leadership.

AWARD TYPES

- **Award of Distinction** (Undergraduate, Chapter, Council, Advisor, Alumnus) honors people and groups who rise above in fraternity communities
- **Laurel Wreath Award** celebrates unique programs and initiatives influencing the fraternity community and greater world
- **Gold and Silver Medal** recognizes lifelong service to the interfraternal community and/or the NIC

HOW TO NOMINATE

Open the online submission portal for the award type. Nominations are accepted through this form only. It may be helpful to read the criteria at the top of the [webpage](#) and review the features on the past years' recipients. You will need:

- **Narrative** (100 to 500 words)
PRO TIP: Be thoughtful and creative. The NIC purposely doesn't provide strict criteria for awards because we want to see innovation, enthusiasm and diversity — but we need you to tell us the story of your nominee in the best way you can. The more information you provide, the more likely your nomination is to stand out.
- **Letters of endorsement**
At least one is required for all entries. Multiple are letters encouraged. There is no length requirement.
 - Undergraduates and Chapters – Both inter/national fraternity and university/college endorsement required
 - Council – University endorsement required
PRO TIP: Alignment with the [IFC SOP](#) is considered by judges
 - Advisor – Either fraternity or university endorsement is required
 - Alumnus – Fraternity endorsement required
- **Additional documentation** (optional)
