

# IFC Jurisdiction.

*The Judicial Board is a committee of representatives from member chapters tasked with reviewing all potential violations of the IFC Judicial Code or Bylaws.*

## WHAT CAN THE JUDICIAL BOARD REVIEW?

- The [IFC Judicial Code](#) covers the basic expectations of all member chapters and members. While it is not an exhaustive list, it provides an outline for the Judicial Board to hold members accountable.
- The [IFC Judicial Policy](#) covers:
  - IFC Constitution, Bylaws, Code of Conduct and policies, rules and regulations of the institution and the general values-based conduct of fraternity men.
  - Behaviors that misrepresent the purpose, mission, vision or ideals of the IFC.
  - Member chapter scholarship, chapter financial delinquencies, failure to attend IFC-sponsored programming with an attendance expectation.

## WHAT SHOULD THE IFC JUDICIAL BOARD REFER ELSEWHERE?

IFC jurisdiction is limited to the IFC Constitution and IFC Code of Conduct.

- If there are potential violations of inter/national organization policy that are not violations of the IFC Constitution or Code of Conduct, the IFC should refer the information to the inter/national organization.
- If there are potential violations of the student code of conduct, the IFC should refer the information to the Office of Student Conduct and work in partnership with the staff there to find resolution.
  - Examples may include but are not limited to: Academic integrity, sexual assault/harassment, hazing, possession or distribution of illegal drugs/substances.
- If there are potential violations in the community that may have criminal implications, the IFC should work cooperatively with the campus or community police departments.
  - Examples may include but are not limited to: Physical violence against others, stalking, sexual assault/harassment, distribution or use of illicit/illegal drugs
