*What does the job of the IFC Member Development Officer entail?

As the IFC Member Development officer, it is your responsibility to support a continual and progressive education curriculum designed to inform, challenge, and prepare fraternity leaders for successful college careers and their lives beyond. The use of fraternity, campus, regional, and national resources is strongly encouraged. Fraternity men should be active with programs and other learning opportunities involving diverse constituencies from across the campus community whenever possible.

The IFC Member Development Officer should work with IFC officers, chapter presidents, advisors, and other stakeholders to determine relevant and appropriate education efforts to meet the current needs of the IFC community. Programming efforts should be collaborative in nature and include content experts to best enhance the fraternity experience. An effective IFC recognizes the need to **develop its members and community through baseline programming and education** that is based on shared interests and relevant topics.

DUTIES

- Develop best practices for new member and member education programs for member fraternities.
- Collect and report new member retention, academic, and involvement statistics in conjunction with other IFC officers.
- Organize, develop, and implement an IFC-based new member orientation program.
- Develop opportunities for continuing member education by collaborating with university offices and departments, alumni and peer student organizations to offer educational programming covering topics such as academic achievement, alcohol consumption, career preparation, civic engagement, hazing, leadership development, sexual assault/abuse, and values and ethics.
- Provide advice and support to member development officers from member fraternities.
- Collaborate with other councils, offices, and student organizations to further community impact and enhance programming efforts.
