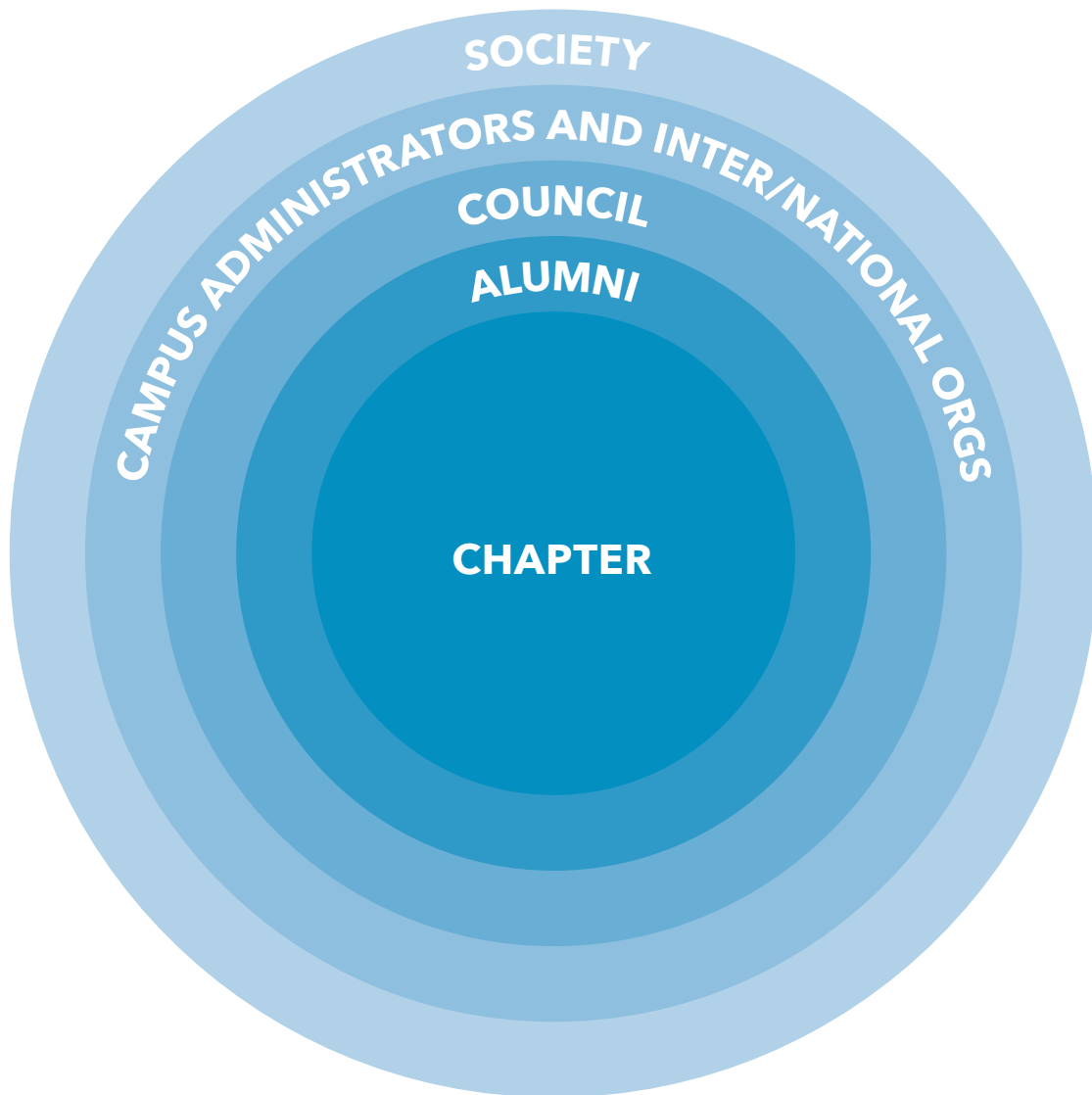


PEER GOVERNANCE
